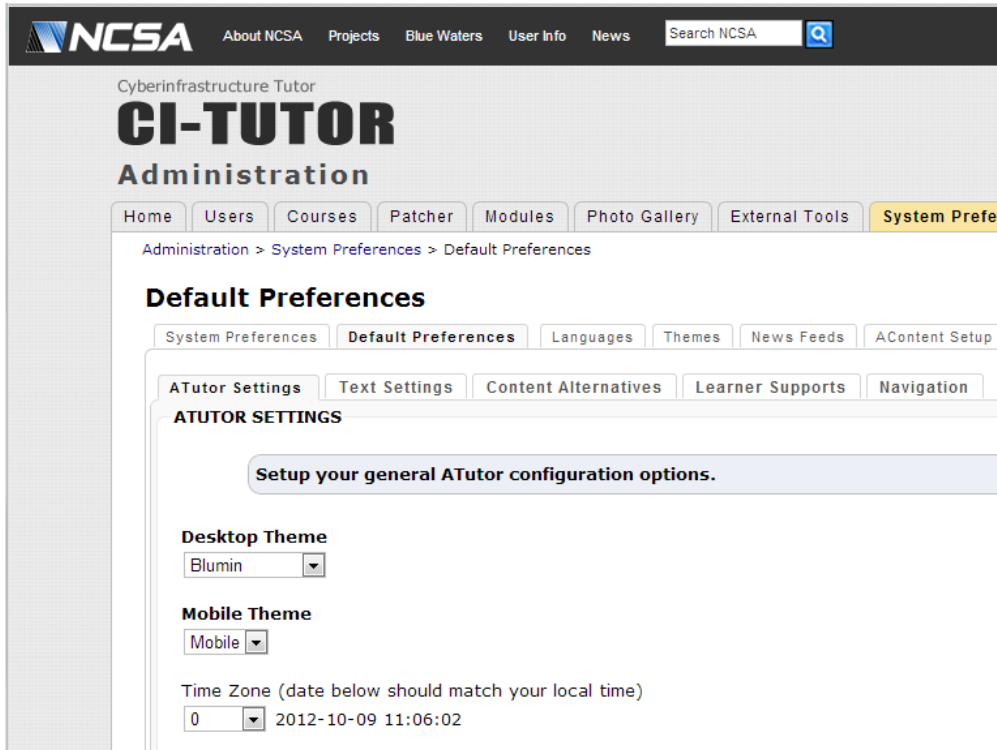
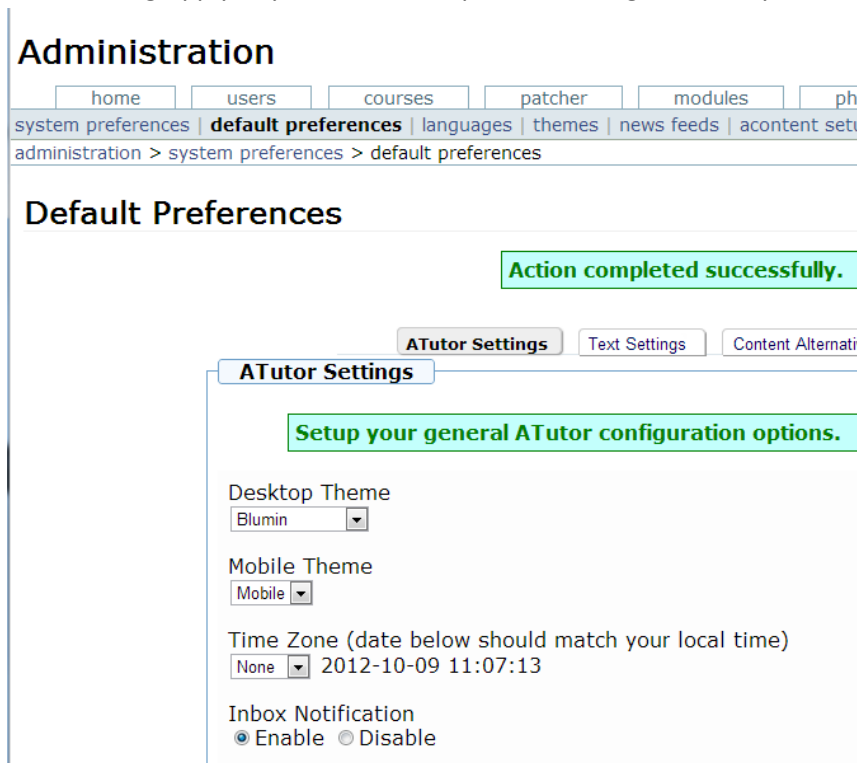


As admin, I set the default desktop theme to my custom theme via the theme management page - mods/_core/themes/index.php. I then need to set some default new user preferences so I switch to the the Default Preferences page, ATutor Settings (mods/_core/users/default_preferences.php?current_tab=0). For this example, I set the Desktop theme to Blumin:



After clicking Apply, my default desktop theme changes from my custom theme to the Blumin theme:



[Or when personal preferences have been disabled in favor of theme categories, the desktop theme reverts to the ATutor default theme rather than remaining as my custom theme.]

To get my custom theme to display again, I have to reset the default desktop theme back to my custom theme from the themes mgmt page - mods/_core/themes/index.php (even though it shows it is already set to the default). Also the database still shows my custom theme is the default (status=2). That tells me that `mods/_core/users/default_preferences.php` is resetting the desktop theme session variable to the value applied to the default user preferred theme. Unless I'm missing something, I don't think setting the Default New User's Preferred Theme value should have any bearing on the site's Default Desktop Theme.

This isn't a show stopper since the default new user preferred theme is being set properly so the student end user isn't affected. Also, it seldom happens since default preferences are not set very often by the admin. It does cause the poor admin a little confusion though.
